The Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI) is a 10-minute drive from Aerocity and 25-minute drive from the venue (depending on traffic).

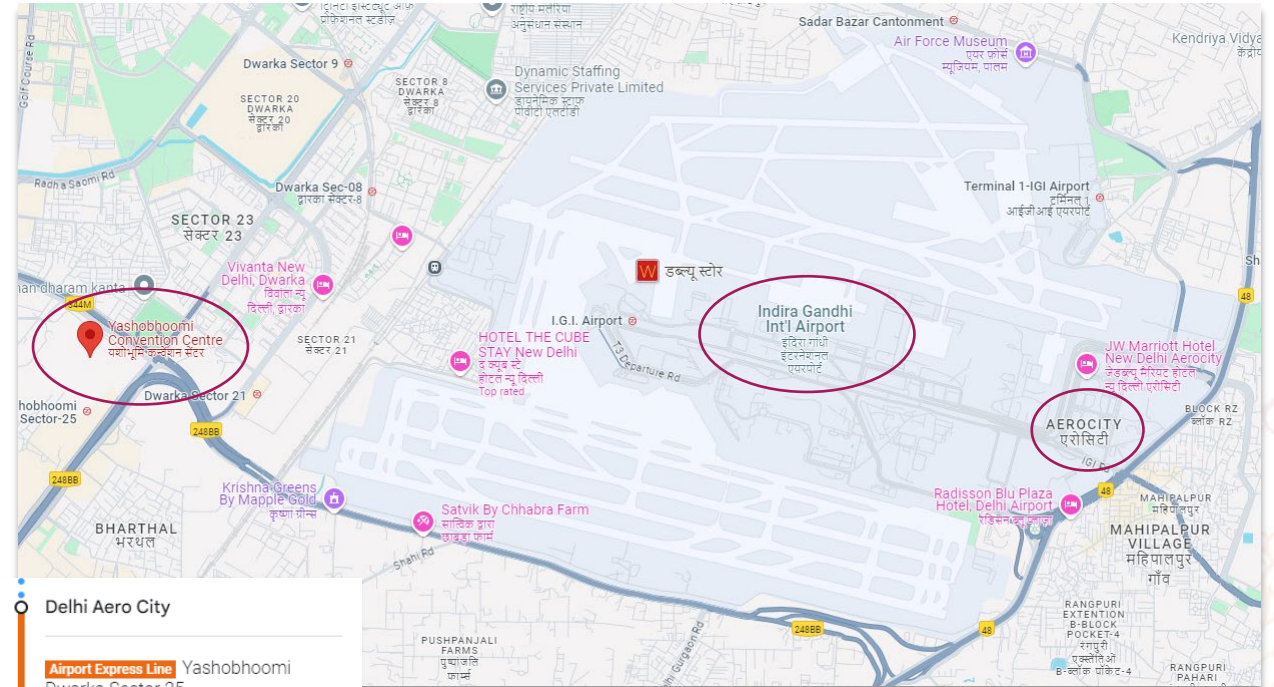

To get to the venue each day, it's recommended to take the metro (2 stops). A shuttle from Aerocity (hotels) to the metro station will be available.

Even though the distance is short, the roads tend to be congested, so it's advisable to refrain from traveling by car or taxi to the venue from Aerocity. Due to the heavy traffic, the journey can take up to an hour.

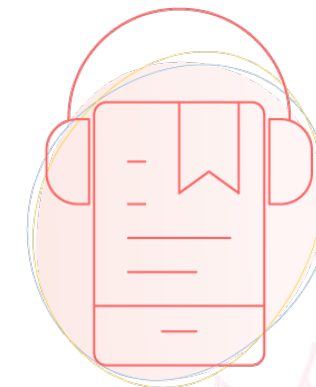
### Theme 3: The Kidney Losing Function
