



VENUE

The airport, venue and hotels are all in close proximity and connected by the metro.

The Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI) is a 10-minute drive from Aerocity and 25minute drive from the venue (depending on traffic).






VENUE

To get to the venue each day, it's recommended to take the metro (2 stops). A shuttle from Aerocity (hotels) to the metro station will be available.

Even though the distance is short, the roads tend to be congested, so it's advisable to refrain from traveling by car or taxi to the venue from Aerocity. Due to the heavy traffic, the journey can take up to an hour.





PROGRAM



Theme 1: Better Kidney Health

Topics covered include preventive and environmental science, population health science, global kidney health, and policy/advocacy, also transplantation as relevant.



Theme 2: The Interconnected Kidney

Topics covered include cardiorenal syndrome, cardiovascular disease, hypertension, epi-nephrology, brain-kidney axis and pulmonary-kidney syndrome, multimorbidity, onconephrology, gut-kidney axis, and kidney liver connect, also transplantation as relevant.



Theme 3: The Kidney Losing Function

Topics covered include dialysis, chronic kidney disease-mineral and bone disorder, anaemia, and interventional nephrology.



Theme 4: The Smart Kidney

Topics covered include genetics, precision medicine, machine learning/AI, complement dysregulation, and rare/orphan kidney diseases, also transplantation as relevant.







CONVENTION CENTER SIDE ELEVATION








