- 1.1. Elevate kidney health on global healthcare agendas by advocating for universal health coverage as well as evidence-based strategies for early-detection and prevention of kidney disease.
- 1.2. Grow the capacity of the global kidney community to deliver evidence-based early-detection and prevention strategies, clinical trials, and access to novel technologies and treatments.
- 1.3. Impact international health policy by maintaining consistent communication and collaboration with the WHO, UN and other key stakeholders.
- 1.4. Increase capacity for sustainable kidney disease surveillance in low-and-middle income countries for optimal clinical care.
- 1.5. Include perspectives of people with kidney disease in ISN activities.
