My name is Olimkhon Sharapov.

I was born in 1987 in Tashkent city in a family of doctors. I studied and graduated from secondary school No. 138 in Tashkent. In 2004-2011, I studied at the Treatment faculty of the Tashkent Medical Academy. In 2011, I entered the magistracy of the Tashkent Medical Academy in the direction of internal diseases. After completing master's degree in 2014, I started working as a doctor in the Department of Nephrology at the third clinic of the Tashkent Medical Academy. In September 2014, I began working as an assistant at the Department of Internal Medicine of the Tashkent Pediatric Medical Institute. During 2014-2017, I taught students at this department, where I became interested in scientific activities. Therefore, I decided to submit a document for doctoral studies in the direction of Internal Medicine at the same department of the Tashkent Pediatric Institute.

Since 2018, I entered the doctoral program under the guidance of the famous nephrologist Professor B.T. Daminov. For 3 years, I was engaged in scientific activities and preparation of a dissertation on the study of cardiovascular diseases in dialysis patients. In addition, in 2021 successfully defended my PhD dissertation on the topic "Cardiovascular diseases in patients receiving program hemodialysis" and received the degree of Doctor of Philosophy.

From 2021 to the present, I have been working as the head of the scientific department of "Adult and Pediatric Nephrology" at the Republican Specialized Scientific and Practical Medical Center for Nephrology and Kidney Transplantation in Tashkent. Moreover, I work as a teacher at the Department of Internal Medicine, Nephrology and Hemodialysis of the Tashkent Pediatric Medical Institute. At the Nephrology Center, I am engaged in scientific, pedagogical, methodological and practical work under the guidance of my mentor, director of the center, Professor Botir Daminov. The center is the leading institution in the country providing practical, educational, methodological, scientific activities. As a researcher at the center, I am daily engaged in research work, examining patients in the departments of the center, teaching masters and residents of the center, publicist activities, and regularly visit the country's regions to train and provide practical assistance to regional doctors. At the department of the institute, I teach internal medicine and nephrology to students.

I am also actively engaged in the development of international cooperation in our center. Since, I am a Board member of the ISN NIS & Russia Regional Board and I am the representative of the NIS & Russia Region in the ISN Advocacy Working Group from. I am also a member of the European Renal Association (as the National Representative of my country), the American Society of Nephrology and the Russian Dialysis Society.
